The theme **Spectrum** celebrates this incredible versatility, showing how a single instrument can evoke brilliance, warmth, shimmer, and depth, as well as raw, breathy, and even percussive or violent sounds.

The word "spectrum" itself suggests range, variety, and wholeness. It reminds us that beauty often lies in contrast, in the blending of bright and dark, soft and bold, familiar and unexpected. It evokes not only the play of color and sound but also the broad and diverse experiences that make up our musical and human communities. For some, it also speaks to pride, visibility, and authenticity, and the courage to be seen and heard in all our colors.

Just as light refracts into a rainbow of hues, the flute reveals a full range of expression that mirrors the complexity and richness of who we are. **Spectrum** is both a musical idea and a human one, a celebration of the voices that, together, create something luminous.




